# A Summertime Story

Late one early summer afternoon in my 14th year, I watched in terror as my father fell from a second story ladder onto our home's concrete driveway. While the fall did not kill him, it did result in serious injuries and major leg and foot surgery followed by months of convalescence. And while he hadn't been a student of history previously, my father grew in that regard that summer and early autumn watching hundreds of televised hours of the historic Watergate Congressional Hearings from the temporary hospital bed in our family's living room. Eventually, he "beat" an initial prognosis that he may never fully nor painlessly walk again. But walk again he did, albeit with a slight limp nearing the final holes during his several weekly rounds of retirement-aged golf!

While these memories remain forever powerfully and permanently etched on my mind and heart, the most powerful memory of that long, difficult summer is of a different sort. For it is a memory of friendship, service, and selfless love.

Shortly after my father returned home that summer to begin his long living room recovery, my mother received a call from my father's co-workers. Out of their love and friendship, they offered to freely finish the task that he and I had begun. Their only request was the availability of cold, liquid refreshments while they worked!

So, a few short days later this group of friends and coworkers arrived with paintbrushes, paint scrapers, buckets, ladders, and GENEROUS hearts. For many hot summer evenings - after they had already worked a hard day's labor - they came and continued working as they scraped, primed, and painted the extensive woodwork on our family's large two-story home. In my father's and our eyes, the newly painted house never looked better.

I am certain that less fishing, less gardening, and even less golfing occurred in our hometown that summer. But something far greater and important did occur. Acts of unexpected compassion, generosity, and selfless love occurred. Acts which changed not only the exterior of our home, but the interior of our hearts as well.

I share this story hoping that you too take time this summer to remember and reflect upon the many generous and selfless acts of love which have occurred in your life. Some of these may have appeared insignificant or small at the time. Some may now exist only in the mists of your memory. And yet isn't the foundation of our lives built upon these acts of love performed by others? If so, then we, in turn, are offered daily opportunities to do the same. May you continue to be blessed in the giving and receiving of grace, life, and love. Or, as we hear each Sunday, "Go in peace to love and serve the Lord."




